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# BACKGROUND


#### 1. Clearwater Power Plant

- a. Commissioned in 2005 and acquired by Riverside in September 2010.
- b. Combined-cycle power plant produces 30 megawatts
- c. Regulated by EPA and SCAQMD

### 2. Continuous Emissions Monitoring Systems (CEMS)

- a. Monitors air emissions on a "24/7/365" basis
- b. Daily /quarterly calibrations and annual 3<sup>rd</sup> party certifications required on emissions analyzers
- c. OEM recommended maintenance part of compliance
- d. Specialized skills and experience needed for maintenance

- 2. Three proposal were submitted. Staff evaluated two qualified proposals.
