### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

#### That the Planning Commission:

- **DETERMINE** that PR-2025-001788, review of the City of Riverside's capital improvement projects for FY 2025/2026, is not subject to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) as this action is not considered a "project" as defined by Section 15378(b)(4), and a determination of consistency has no potential to result in a direct or indirect physical change in the environment:
