The minutes of March 25, 2026, were approved as presented.

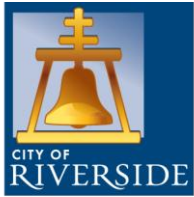
Absences

CITY ATTORNEY REPORT ON CLOSED SESSION ACTIONS

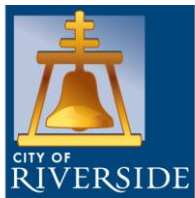
There were no reportable actions from the City Attorney regarding Closed Session discussions.
