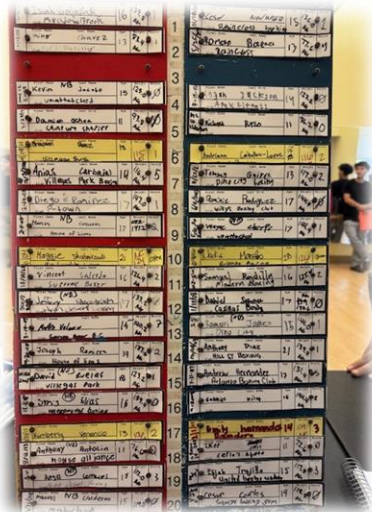

- Next show: September 6, 2025, at Villegas Park

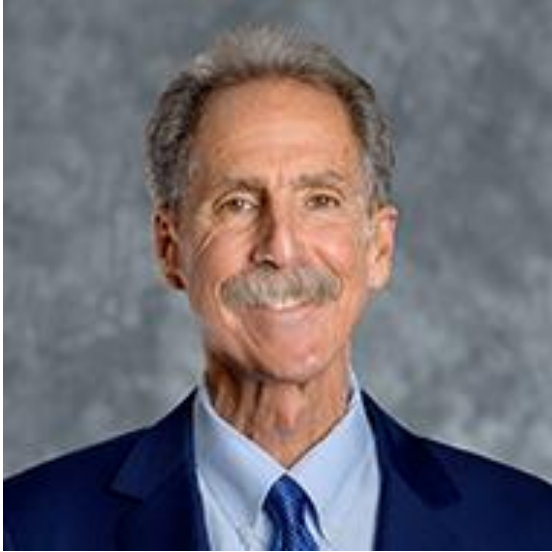
