### Mission

The City of Riverside and the Transportation Board are committed to advancing multi-modal transportation network initiatives, ensuring the safe, efficient, sustainable, and equitable usage of the right of way, and movement of pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists.

### STRATEGIC PRIORITIES

The Transportation Board 2025 Workplan aligns with the following Envision Riverside 2025 Strategic Priorities:

1. **Ensure all Wards are represented at Transportation Board meetings by establishing a board member attendance of 80%.**



#### **High Performing Government** Goal 5.3

Enhance communication and collaboration with community members to improve transparency, build public trust and encourage shared decision-making.

2. **Recommend pilot and long-term complete streets-oriented improvements for regulatory compliance and community safety enhancement including, but not limited to: pedestrian crossings & corridors, bicycle facilities, neighborhood traffic calming, speed limits signs, truck restrictions signs, parking signs, turn restriction signs, etc.**

Provide, expand, and ensure equitable access to sustainable modes of transportation that connect people to opportunities such as employment, education, healthcare and community amenities

3. **Provide recommendations during annual review of the City's Traffic Signal Synchronization Master Plan and proposed Capital Improvement Projects.**

Maintain, protect, and improve assets and infrastructure within the City's built environment to ensure and enhance reliability, resiliency, sustainability and facilitate connectivity.

4. Explore innovative transportation solutions to address neighborhood community challenges and solicit feedback through public outreach and engagement efforts.
