



Bid 8221 – FY 2025/2026 Senate Bill-1 Street Maintenance and Downtown Bollards Improvements

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BACKGROUND

1. On April 28, 2017, the California Governor signed Senate Bill-1 (SB-1), known as the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, to address basic road maintenance, rehabilitation and critical safety needs.
2. SB-1 increases gas taxes and vehicle registration fees and provides for inflation adjustments to fund these needs.



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BACKGROUND

3. The California State Controller's Office deposits various portions of these revenues into the State's Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA). A percentage of the RMRA funds are apportioned to eligible cities and counties as part the SB-1 Local Street and Roads Program (LSRP).
4. On August 5, 2025, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 24295 to approve the FY2025-26 Project List to be completed utilizing the projected FY2025-26 SB-1 revenue.



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BACKGROUND

5. The Public Works Department utilizes a Pavement Management Program and receives service requests from residents to plan various maintenance improvements throughout the City.
6. Every fiscal year, the Public Works Department budgets a portion of State Gas Tax, County Measure A, and Measure Z revenues for street rehabilitation of City arterial and minor streets. This project will rehabilitate marginal, poor, and very poor roads.



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CURRENT PROJECT

1. Rehabilitate 3.7 miles of arterial and collector streets:
 - Day St. (Southbound) from 60 Fwy Ramps to Eucalyptus Ave.
 - Brockton Ave. from Indiana Ave. to Arlington Ave.
 - Wood Rd. from Van Buren Blvd. to John F Kennedy Dr.
 - La Sierra Ave. from Gramercy Place to Cypress Ave.
 - Washington St. from Indiana Ave. to Victoria Ave.
2. Resurface 2.7 miles of Minor streets within four neighborhoods.



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CURRENT PROJECT

3. Apply recycled asphalt millings from Wood Rd. to Harrington Rd. and Ferrari Dr., to help reduce dust, minimize sediment runoff, and mitigate erosion.
4. Reconstruct damaged concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, and non-compliant pedestrian ramps.
5. Install new signing and striping throughout all maintenance locations.
6. Various traffic signal modifications.



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CURRENT PROJECT

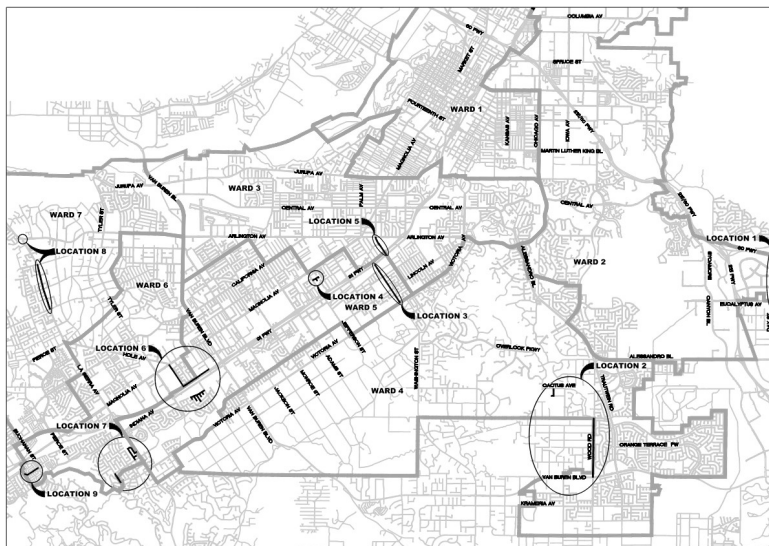
7. Implement citywide curb extension pilot project with pavement markings.
8. Install 26 edge-lit stop signs at various locations throughout the city.
9. Install seven solar-powered speed feedback signs at strategic locations throughout the city.
10. Install 132 pedestrian safety bollards throughout the downtown area to enhance pedestrian safety and protect public spaces from unauthorized vehicle access.



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SB-1 LOCATION MAP

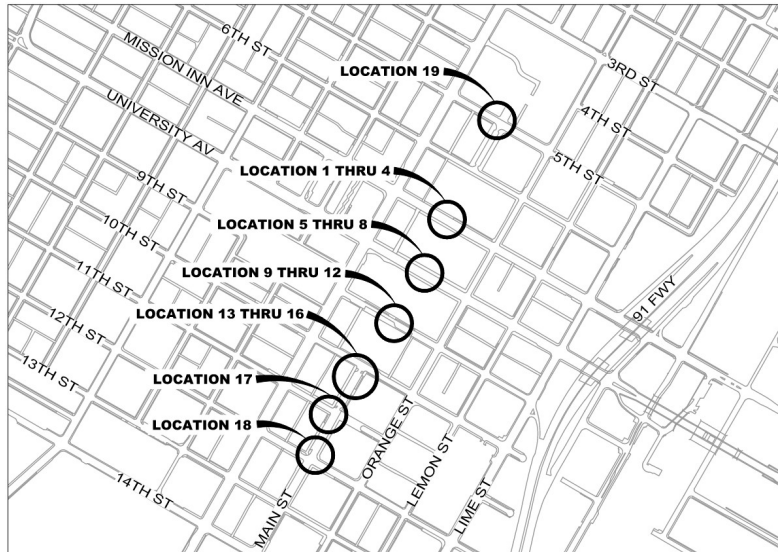


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DOWNTOWN BOLLARDS LOCATION MAP

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RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Award Bid No. 8221 for the construction of 2025/26 SB-1 Street Maintenance Improvements and 2025/26 Downtown Bollards Installation for the term of one-hundred thirty (130) working days after the commencement date specified in the Notice to Proceed, to Onyx Paving Company, Inc. of Yorba Linda, California, in the amount of \$7,677,000;
2. Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the Agreement for Construction with Onyx Paving Company, Inc., including making minor non-substantial changes, subject to the availability of funds; and
3. With at least five affirmative votes, authorize the Chief Financial Officer, or designee, to record a supplemental appropriation in the Measure A Fund in the amount of \$755,050 in the Main Street Bollards project expenditure accounts from available fund balance.

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
