BID DESCRIPTION: The purpose of the bar screens is to remove large objects such as diaper wipes, feminine products, rags, rocks, tree branches, and plastic bags from the wastewater. The bar screens not only allow downstream processes to be more efficient, they also protect and extend the service life of downstream equipment, which translates to significant cost savings for the City.

The current headworks facility at RWQCP was constructed in 1999. The existing bar screens have reached the end of their useful life and need to be replaced. The lack of spare parts due to long lead times has caused the existing bar screens to be inoperable for extended time periods and impacted the treatment capacity. The proposed equipment shall be retrofitted into the existing channels to avoid major infrastructure modifications cost and lower the overall project costs.
