### **BACKGROUND**

May 10, 2011 – City Council adopted a Mitigated Negative Declaration and approved Case EPW-10-002 for Van Buren Blvd. widening (Jurupa Ave. to Santa Ana River bridge).

**Sept. 2012** – Riverside County reconstructed the Van Buren Blvd. bridge to six lanes (3 each way), but roadway connections remained two lanes.

May 20, 2014 – City Council funded widening of northbound Van Buren to three lanes; southbound widening postponed due to lack of funding.

**Feb. 5, 2019** – City Council approved original TUMF agreement with WRCOG for southbound widening.

### **CURRENT PROJECT**

- Widen southbound Van Buren BI (west side) to add 3rd lane
- Retaining wall, streetlights, grading and paving
- curb/gutter/sidewalk, storm drains Improvements
- Traffic signing and striping both southbound and northbound
- •Santa Ana River Trail bikeway realignment
- •Safer, smoother corridor for vehicles & bikes
- Construction start: Summer 2028

## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 1. Approve First Amendment to TUMF Agreement with WRCOG for Van Buren Blvd. Widening (planning, engineering, construction) in the amount of \$4,475,000, increasing total agreement to \$4,635,000;
- 2. Authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute the First Amendment and make minor, non-substantive changes; and

3. With at least five affirmative votes, authorize the Chief Financial Officer, or designee, to record an increase in revenues and appropriate an equal amount in expenditures in the amount of \$4,568,911.37 in the Transportation Uniform Mitigation Fee Fund, Van Buren Boulevard – Jurupa SAR Bridge project revenue and expenditure accounts.
