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COMMUNICATIONS

UPDATES ON CONFERENCES, SEMINARS AND REGIONAL MEETINGS ATTENDED BY COMMISSIONERS

Commissioner Lee shared his meeting with the Blue Envelope Program on July 29th, which provides resources for disabled or neurodivergent adults who drive.

Commissioner Tarmo brought up the upcoming Planes and Treats and Goeske Health Center Health Fair as events Commissioners may be interested in attending.

Commissioner Stuart suggested attending the wellness event held by the Riverside Medical Clinic Charitable Foundation on September 29th.

Commissioner Krick contacted the state commission for a standing list of commissions on disabilities but was informed that such a list does not exist; he suggested that the Commission could assist in assembling a list of similar groups in Southern California.

Commissioner Cleary attended the Inland Empire Abilities fair in July and found that none of the attendees were aware that the Commission on Disabilities existed in Riverside.

Commissioner Dunston also attended the Inland Empire Abilities fair and passed out cards to see if any attendees would be interested in attending or presenting at a future Commission on Disabilities meeting.

ITEMS FOR FUTURE COMMITTEE CONSIDERATION

Commissioner Lee suggested reaching out to Romeo & Friends for a future Commission presentation.

Chair Trimm, Commissioner Stuart, Commissioner Pellegrino, Commissioner Tarmo, and Commissioner Dunston expressed concern over a lack of outreach and suggested forming an Ad Hoc Committee for upcoming future events. Commissioner Krick suggested creating a new Standing Committee instead.



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Chair Trimm suggested a presentation on the abilities of the Commission and an overview on Ad Hoc Committees.
