

# ELECTRIC ADVANCED METERING INFRASTRUCTURE METERS 10% CONTINGENCY

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## **BACKGROUND**

On December 9, 2024, the Board of Public Utilities approved Work Order No. 2508277

- 1. Amount: \$25,250,000
- 2. Included the purchase of 80,000 additional Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) meters with McAvoy and Markham for fiscal years 2024-2025 through 2028-2029, in the not to exceed amount of \$15,350,000



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### **DISCUSSION**

- 1. A new 17% U.S. tariff on goods from the Philippines affects Tantalus modules in RPU's AMI meters
- 2. The tariff is under legal review, with enforcement fluctuating; a 90-day suspension via Executive Order expires July 9, 2025
- 3. Tantalus is currently covering 50% of the added \$7.65-per-unit tariff, but this is not guaranteed to continue
- 4. RPU sources AMI meters from Itron via distributor McAvoy and Markham, with Tantalus modules integrated at the factory
- 5. Ongoing trade and legal uncertainty pose a high risk of increased meter costs during the rest of the deployment



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## **APPROVAL REQUEST**

- Staff is requesting approval to add a 10% change order authority to the contract, consistent with standard City and Board contracting practices
- 2. A contingency was not originally included due to the longterm nature of the agreement, but this addition aligns the contract with other City and utility projects
- 3. The 10% authority will allow RPU to manage potential cost impacts, including those related to the newly imposed 17% tariff, without requiring multiple returns to the Board



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### FISCAL IMPACT

- 1. A 10% change order authority is requested, not to exceed \$1,535,000
- 2. The estimated cost impact of the 17% tariff on the remaining 70,800 meters is approximately \$542,000.
  - a) 9,200 meters were delivered prior to the tariff implementation and are not subject to the additional cost
- 3. Funds are available in Account 6130200-470823 System Automation Advanced Metering Infrastructure



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## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

That the Board of Public Utilities approve a 10%, or \$1,535,000, change order authority for Purchase Order No. 253356 with McAvoy and Markham for 80,000 electric meters, in the not to exceed amount of \$1,535,000 for Work Order No. 2508277 bringing the total Work Order amount from \$25,250,000 to \$26,785,000.



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
