

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
3 CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR
4 2026/27 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND
ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017.

5 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter
6 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the California Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in
7 April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the
10 residents of the City of Riverside are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community
11 and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

12 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside must adopt by resolution a list of all projects proposed to
13 receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1,
14 which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for
15 the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

16 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside will receive an estimated Eight Million Nine Hundred
17 Eighty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars (\$8,988,184) in RMRA funding in Fiscal
18 Year 2026-27 from SB 1; and

19 WHEREAS, this is the tenth year in which the City of Riverside is receiving SB 1 funding and
20 will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety
21 improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for
22 the traveling public that may not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

23 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside has undergone a public process to ensure public input into
24 this community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

25 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside used a Pavement Management Plan to develop the SB 1
26 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that
27 also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

1 WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City of Riverside maintain and rehabilitate
2 multiple streets/roads and add/improve active transportation infrastructure throughout the City as
3 identified and described in Exhibit A hereto and incorporated herein; and

4 WHEREAS, the 2023 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found
5 that the City of Riverside's streets and roads are in an "at lower risk" condition and this revenue will
6 help maintain the overall quality of our road system; and

7 WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads
8 infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets
9 infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials, and practices will have significant
10 positive co-benefits statewide.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
12 California, as follows:

- 13 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- 14 2. The fiscal year 2026-27 list of projects planned to be funded with Road Maintenance
15 and Rehabilitation Account revenues are identified in Exhibit "A" hereto.
