

SECOND AMENDMENT TO SERVICES AGREEMENT

SYNAGRO-WWT, INC.

Biosolids Hauling and Disposal/Reuse Services for City of Riverside, Regional Water Quality Control Plant (RFP No. 2223)

This SECOND AMENDMENT TO SERVICES AGREEMENT ("Second Amendment") is made and entered into this ____ day of _____, _____, by and between the CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a California charter city and municipal corporation ("City"), and SYNAGRO-WWT, INC., a Maryland corporation authorized to do business in California ("Contractor").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2023, City and Contractor entered into a Services Agreement for Services for Biosolids Hauling and Disposal/Reuse Services for City of Riverside, Regional Water Quality Control Plant (RFP No. 2223) ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2023, City and Contractor entered into a First Amendment to Services Agreement ("First Amendment") to extend the Term of the Agreement and add additional Compensation; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is set to expire June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor desire to extend the Agreement for an additional two (2) year Term to begin July 1, 2025, and to end June 30, 2027, and add additional compensation in the amount of Eight Million Three Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Ten Dollars (\$8,323,810.00) for the extended Term of the Agreement, not to exceed total Contract Price of Eighteen Million One Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Two Hundred Four Dollars (\$18,134,204.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals which are incorporated herein by this reference, City and Contractor agree as follows:

1. Section 2 of the Agreement, "Term," is hereby amended to extend the Term by two (2) years, from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2027.

2. Section 3 of the Agreement, "Compensation," is hereby amended to increase compensation in the additional amount of Eight Million Three Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Eight Hundred Ten Dollars (\$8,323,810.00) for the extended term of the Agreement, not to exceed total Contract Price of Eighteen Million One Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Two Hundred Four Dollars (\$18,134,204.00).

3. Exhibit "B," Compensation Schedule, is hereby amended in accordance with the terms set forth in Exhibit "B-2," attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.




