Project Details:

- **Project Name:** Third Street Grade Separation
- **Location:** On Third Street in the city of Riverside, between Vine Street and Park Avenue
- **Scope:** Replace existing 4 lane (2 lanes in each direction) railroad crossing to a 4 lane (2 lanes in each direction) grade separation
- **Estimated Construction Cost:** \$59 million
- **Awarded Grant Program:** Community Project Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending Cycle 2 (2023)
- **CPFCDs Funding Amount:** \$3 million
- **Local Match Required:** 11.47%

Agencies Involved:

- **Designated Awardee:** RCTC
- **Recipient Agency/Will Administer the Project:** City of Riverside

Agreement Terms:


1. RCTC agrees to relinquish the award for the Project to the City of Riverside to administer the Project.

3. Both parties acknowledge this change will enhance project alignment with local priorities and facilitate successful implementation.


