DEFERRED MAINTENANCE FUNDS Per City Council approval, the Parks Division was awarded \$17.5 million dollars in Measure Z Funds to address repairs to assets and infrastructure that got delayed or rescheduled into the future due to limited resources.

- a) \$3.5 million per fiscal year
- b) Funds awarded for 5 consecutive fiscal years

ARPA one-time funds are addressing other immediate deferred maintenance projects.



DEFERRED MAINTENANCE PRIORITIES

Projects are prioritized using the following factors:

- 1. Risk to Health, Safety and Environment;
- 2. Regulatory or Mandated Requirements;
- 3. Asset Condition, Annual Recurring Costs and Asset Longevity;
- 4. Community Investment and Economic Prosperity;
- 5. Level and Quality of Service;
- 6. Sustainability and Conservation;
- 7. Funding Availability;
- 8. Project Readiness

Goal is to get on a deferred maintenance schedule.







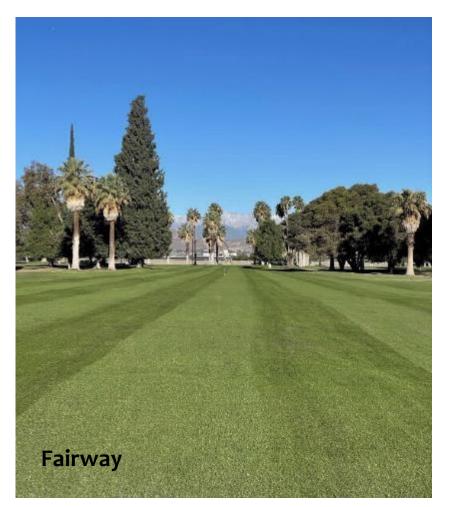
