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## **BACKGROUND**

- 1976 Mills Act enacted by State
  - Allows for cost recovery
- 2004 City Council establishes City Mills Act Program
  - Fees have varied over the course of program
- May 10, 2023 Financial Performance and Budget Committee referred fees to CHB
- July 19, 2023 CHB Reviewed Fees
  - 30% cost recovery recommended
