#### **ISSUE:**

# **BACKGROUND**:

The Airport Manager's Operation and Activity Report is provided to inform the Airport Commission (Commission) about operations, City Council actions, events, meetings and other issues concerning the Riverside Municipal Airport (Airport).

While revenues are higher than projected for this point in the fiscal year, this is due partly to increases in Riverside Airport Café revenues, resulting in larger Percentage Revenue Share, 100% occupancy of aircraft hangars, and increased fuel sales resulting in higher fuel flow revenues. Expenditures are somewhat lower than projected for this point in the fiscal year due partly to cost cutting measures implemented by the new Airport Manager.

# **Highlights**

Airport Super Bloom. Visitors and tenants alike enjoyed a beautiful super bloom on the airfield during the past few months.

*RPD Helo.* During April, Riverside Police Department received the first of two new H125 helicopters. The second one is schedule to arrive in June.

Airport Leasing Program. The airport currently has 157 total aircraft hangars – 83 of which are city owned and 74 of which are privately owned and are located within the Port-A-Port leased area.

*New Equipment.* The airport received a John Deere Gator and Billy Goat blower to support the maintenance of the airfield and grounds.

Gemende Hangar Development lease amendment approved.

## **Upcoming City Council and Committee Actions:**

Addition of one full-time Airport Operations Specialist position to extend evening hours coverage.
