

# MEASURE Z – BID 7994 FY 2022/23 ARTERIAL AND MINOR STREET MAINTENANCE, PHASE 2

#### **Public Works Department**

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#### **BACKGROUND**

- The Public Works Department utilizes a Pavement Management Program and receives service requests from residents to plan various maintenance improvements throughout the City.
- 2. Every fiscal year, the Public Works Department budgets a portion of State Gas Tax, County Measure A, and City Measure Z revenues for street rehabilitation of City arterial and minor streets. This project will primarily focus on rehabilitation of streets in poor condition.



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#### **BACKGROUND**

- On December 6, 2022, the City Council received a list of proposed maintenance locations to be completed with the various Fiscal Year 2022/23 funding sources.
- 4. The maintenance improvements included Bid 7994 were locations included in the complete list provided in the report from December 2022. The remaining locations outlined in that list are included in other projects.



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### **CURRENT PROJECT**

- 1. Resurface 2.7 miles on three collector streets including:
  - Cypress Avenue from Crest Ave. to Van Buren Blvd.
  - Gramercy Place from La Sierra Ave. to Crest Ave.
  - Norwood Avenue from Golden Ave. to La Sierra Ave.
- 2. Resurface 3.7 miles of local streets within four different neighborhoods.
- 3. Provide 0.1 miles of slurry preservation on one local street.



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#### **CURRENT PROJECT**

- 4. Reconstruct damaged concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, and non-compliant pedestrian ramps within all rehabilitation locations.
- 5. Install 0.1 miles of high friction surface treatment on one Arterial street including:
  - Fourteenth Street from Bermuda Ave. to Sedgwick Ave.
- 6. Install new signing and striping throughout as necessary.



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
### **CURRENT PROJECT**

- 7. Install new traffic signal modifications at the following intersections:
  - Orange Street and 10<sup>th</sup> Street
  - Canyon Crest Drive and Linden Street
  - Tyler Street and Indiana Avenue
