## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, OFFERING A REWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000 FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE DETERMINATION OF THE IDENTITY OF, AND THE APPREHENSION OF, THE PERSON OR PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MURDER OF ISAIAH ARVISO.

WHEREAS, the City of Riverside may offer and pay rewards as authorized by Section 53069.5 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, Section 53069.5 specifically authorizes the City to offer and pay a reward, the amount thereof to be determined by the City for information leading to the determination of the identify of, and the apprehension of, any person whose willful misconduct results in injury or death to any person; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2001, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 19873, approving the Riverside Police Department's Reward Program and authorizing its implementation; and

WHEREAS, on Sunday, May 28, 2023, at approximately 5:13 p.m., Riverside Police Department officers responded to the alleyway in the 3500 block of Chicago Avenue regarding multiple calls of shots fired with two subjects hit by gunfire; and

WHEREAS, upon arrival, officers located two subjects in the alleyway suffering from apparent gunshot wounds, including a male juvenile victim who suffered a single gunshot wound to his hip and 18-year-old victim Isaiah Arviso, who was critically injured with multiple gunshot wounds and was transported to at a local hospital, where he was pronounced deceased; and

WHEREAS, Riverside Police Department's Robbery – Homicide Unit responded and assumed the investigation with the assistance of the Forensic Unit; and

WHEREAS, Riverside Police Department detectives interviewed several people in the area, but no one could provide information; and

WHEREAS, over the past several months, detectives have continued to work the case and up to this point have exhausted all leads; and

WHEREAS, a press release was distributed regarding the incident in 2023, but no additional information regarding the homicide investigation has been obtained and the investigation remains open and information is still being sought about the shooting as of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, Riverside Police Department detectives believe there may be witnesses to the events leading up to the shooting or the shooting itself who have yet to come forward; and

WHEREAS, the Riverside Police Department believes that offering the reward of \$10,000 to the public for assistance could yield useful information that could possibly lead to the identification and the apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Isaiah Arviso; and

WHEREAS, the offer would be consistent with and is taken for the immediate protection of public peace, health, and safety; and

WHEREAS, the offense was of such a nature or committed under special circumstances that as a matter of public policy, the City of Riverside should provide a reward as an added inducement or incentive for persons to come forth with information leading to the arrest of the perpetrator(s); and

WHEREAS, the offense was especially heinous, atrocious, or cruel and manifested exceptional depravity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that a reward in the amount of \$10,000 is hereby approved and authorized for information leading to the determination of the identity of, and the apprehension of, any person responsible for the acts stated above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the offer of reward by the City shall be effective for a period of sixty (60) days or for the term of any extension thereof which may be approved by the City Council prior to the termination of the offer of reward. An offer of reward by the City shall terminate by payment, by revocation, or by withdrawal thereof by the City Council by resolution, motion, or council report adopted by a majority vote of the City Council or by expiration of the time period set forth in the resolution offering the reward or any extension thereof which was approved by the City Council while the offer was otherwise effective.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all decisions with respect to the relevance or materiality of information received, whether or not utilized in establishing the determination of the identity of and

1	the apprehension of any one or more persons, and whether such information provides a basis for the
2	payment of a reward, are within the sole discretion of the City Council.
3	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all determinations effective, or dispositive of the offer of
4	reward, shall be within the sole discretion of the City Council and shall be final.
5	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Section 53069.5 of the Government Code of
6	the State of California, the person or persons responsible for the murder of Isaiah Arviso shall be liable
7	for the amount of any reward paid pursuant to this Section and if the person is an unemancipated
8	minor, his or her parent or guardian shall also be liable for the amount.
