## **RESOLUTION NO.**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, 2 CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING NOTICE TO CURRENT NON-EXCLUSIVE COMMERCIAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE PROVIDERS 3 PURSUANT TO PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTION 49520 REGARDING CONTINUATION SERVICES 5-YEAR PERIOD. 4 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside ("City") is a community of about 314,998, ranked as the 5 12th most populous city in California, with projected annual growth of 0.51%. Currently, there are 6 63,484 Residential Solid Waste Accounts and 7,408 Commercial Accounts; and 7 WHEREAS, current solid waste collection services are provided through a combination of 8 City staff and franchise agreements; and 9 WHEREAS, City collection staff provide residential collection services for approximately 10 two thirds of the City's residential customers; the remaining one third of residential customers are 11 currently serviced by Burrtec Waste Industries through an exclusive agreement, which expires on 12 June 30, 2023; and 13 WHEREAS, commercial collection service is provided through non-exclusive agreements 14 with Burrtec Waste Industries, Arakelian Enterprises dba Athens Services, and CR&R 15 Environmental Services ("Commercial Contractors"). These agreements have been in place since 16 2001 and are set to expire on June 30, 2023; and 17 WHEREAS, Public Resources Code section 40059 provides that a City may determine that 18 aspects of solid waste handling are a matter of local concern and that the City may contract for 19 such services with or without use of a competitive bidding process. Section 40059 further provides 20 that the governing body of a local government agency may by resolution or ordinance, prescribe 21 terms and conditions upon which authority to provide solid waste handling services may be 22 granted; and 23 WHEREAS, Riverside Municipal Code ("RMC") section 6.04.050 provides that no 24

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WHEREAS, RMC section 6.06.030 provides that no persons, firm or corporation, other
 than one of the City authorized solid waste haulers acting pursuant to their contract with the City,
 shall collect commercial solid waste, recyclable or organic recyclable material within the City; and

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2022, the City issued RFP No. 2219, soliciting qualified
vendors to submit proposals for Residential and Commercial Garbage, Recyclable Material, and
Organic Waste Collection Services; and

WHEREAS, after evaluating responsive proposals, City staff determined that Arakelian
Enterprises dba Athens Services ("Athens Services") submitted the highest scoring proposal for
both residential and commercial services; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City to award an exclusive franchise agreement to Athens
Services for residential and commercial collection services for a five-year term with options to
extend annually up to 15 years total, through June 30, 2028; and

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code section 49520 provides that certain existing solid
waste handling service providers may provide their services for a period of up-to five years
following notice of the City's determination to transition to an exclusive waste service
arrangement; and

WHEREAS, the 5-year continuation period provided for in Public Recourses Code section
49520, does not apply where services were previously provided through an exclusive agreement;
and;

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code section 49520 states that any solid waste enterprise exercising rights of continued service is limited to "those services" previously authorized by franchise, contract, license, or permit, such that the solid waste enterprise exercising said continuation rights only holds such rights as to its pre-existing service accounts; and

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code section 49521 provides a solid waste enterprise providing continuation services is subject to the following conditions: (a) The services of the solid waste enterprise shall be in substantial compliance with the terms and conditions of the contract and meet the quality and frequency of services required by the City; and (b) the solid waste enterprise may be required to adhere to rates that are comparable to those established by the City.

 follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: The recitals set forth above are all true and correct and are incorporated herein
 <u>Section 2</u>: The City intends to award an exclusive franchise for Residential and
 Commercial Solid Waste, Garbage, Recyclable Material, and Organic Waste Collection Services.
 <u>Section 3</u>: Since the City presently uses non-exclusive agreements for Commercial Solid
 Waste Collection Services, the present Commercial Contractors shall comply with Public
 Resources Code section 49520 and 49521 for a period of five years ending June 30, 2028.

<u>Section 4</u>: Any Commercial Contractor providing continuation services in accordance with
 section 49520 shall provide services to those existing accounts held as of June 30, 2023 and shall
 provide services in accordance with the terms and conditions of their collection services
 agreements with the City.

13 <u>Section 5</u>: The Commercial Contractor's right to provide continuation services shall be for
14 a period of five years ending June 30, 2028.

<u>Section 6</u>: Since the City's previous residential agreement was an exclusive agreement,
 this resolution does not apply to residential services and as such there will be no right to
 continuation services for Residential Solid Waste, Garbage, Recyclable Material, and Organic
 Waste Collection Services.

19 Section 7: The City Manager, or designee, shall cause a copy of this resolution to be served
 20 via certified mail to each of the current Commercial Contractors.
