### **OVERVIEW**

- Riverside Municipal Code requirement to present fees and charges to the City Council annually in conjunction with the City annual budget.
- Last citywide fees and charges study: 2015
- Current fees and charges study initiated in 2021; placed on hold pending new City Manager
- Staff proposes a 7.5% CPI increase pending the completion of the citywide fees and charges study

### FAIRMOUNT GOLF COURSE FEE REVIEW

- The last fee study was conducted in 2019. The last fee increase took effect July 1, 2021.
- January 2023 study shows that fees are under market value.
- Goal of PRCSD is to offer competitive pricing but stay within market value. To ensure PRCSD is receiving adequate revenue for use of its amenity.


