SUBJECT: CONTINUE REVIEW STAGE TWO OF THE CRIMINAL CASE BOOK FOR OFFICER INVOLVED DEATH CASE #210006980 – J. BLACK

ISSUE:

Continue Review Stage Two of the Criminal Case Book for Officer Involved Death case #210006980 – J. Black.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Community Police Review Commission:

1. Continue Review Stage Two of the Criminal Case Book for Officer Involved Death case #210006980 – J. Black - identify any fact finding, requests for training, and/or investigation associated with the Criminal Case Book for Officer Involved Death case #210006980 – J. Black to be presented at the March 27, 2024, Community Police Review Commission meeting; and
2. Begin Stage Three - Policies and Procedures related to the Criminal Case Book for Officer Involved Death case #210006980 – J. Black

BACKGROUND:

Chair Berrellez opened the review of the Criminal Case Book for Officer Involved Death case #210006980 – J. Black at the January 24, 2024. Stage One of the Review Process – Commissioner Review includes the review of Officer Involved Death (OID) investigation materials. As part of the Stage One Review Process, the Independent Investigator assigned to Community Police Review Commission (CPRC) presented an overview of the OID case, a Rationale Worksheet, Fact Sheet, and projected case benchmarks. The Stage One Review Process should be completed within 30-days after the Criminal Case Book has been posted.

DISCUSSION:

At the February 28, 2024, CPRC meeting with Chair Berrellez, Commissioners DeBrier, Huerta, Hiraes, and Gutierrez present the Commission requested to continue Stage Two of the Review Process. Stage Two includes Fact Finding, Requests for Training & Investigation. Any requests associated with the Stage Two process will be requested through discussion at the March 27, 2024, CPRC meeting. Any requests are anticipated to be satisfied at the April 24, 2024, CPRC meeting.

With a consensus of the majority, the Commission may proceed to the next stage of the review process, Stage Three – review of policies and procedures applicable to OID. During Stage Three of the review process,
