

## MEASURE Z – BID 7908 FY 2021/22 ARTERIAL AND MINOR STREET MAINTENANCE, PHASE 2

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# **BACKGROUND**

- 1. The Public Works Department utilizes a Pavement Management Program and receives service requests from residents to plan various maintenance improvements throughout the City.
- 2. Every fiscal year, the Public Works Department budgets a portion of State Gas Tax, County Measure A, and City Measure Z revenues for street rehabilitation of City arterial and minor streets. This project will focus on rehabilitation of streets in poor condition.



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# **BACKGROUND**

- 3. On November 16, 2021, the City Council received a list of proposed maintenance locations to be completed with the various Fiscal Year 2021/22 funding sources.
- 4. The maintenance improvements included Bid 7908 were locations included in the complete list provided in the report from November 2021. The remaining locations outlined in that list are included in other projects.



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# **CURRENT PROJECT**

- 1. Resurface 0.6 miles on one Arterial street including:
  - Westbound Alessandro Boulevard from Mission Grove Parkway to Communications Center Drive.
- 2. Resurface 10.9 miles of local and collector streets within nine different neighborhoods and provide slurry preservation on one street. Resurfacing on collector streets include:
  - Grove Community Drive from Plainview Street to Gardenia Vista Drive (0.7 Miles)
  - Seventh St from Kansas to Chicago (0.5 miles)

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# **CURRENT PROJECT**

- 3. Reconstruct damaged concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, and non-compliant pedestrian ramps within all rehabilitation locations.
- 4. Install new signing and striping throughout as necessary.
- 5. Construct a missing segment of new sidewalk on Mountain View Avenue easterly of Sheppard Street.
- 6. Replace 670 feet of existing chain link fence with a new 7-foot high wrought iron fence on Motor Circle.




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# **LOCATION MAP**

- 1. Award Bid. No. 7908 for a construction contract for 2021/22 Arterial and Minor Year Streets Fiscal Maintenance, Phase 2 to R.J. Noble Company of Orange, California, in the amount of \$10,272,720; and
- 2. Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the construction contract, including making minor and non-substantive changes.



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
