2 3	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE DISPLAY OF THE DISABILITY PRIDE MONTH FLAG AT CITY FACILITIES DURING THE MONTH OF JULY.			
4	WHEREAS, on January 17, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 23947 establishing			
5	the City of Riverside Flag Policy ("Flag Policy"), attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated			
6	herein by reference; and			
7	WHEREAS, the Flag Policy set forth guidelines to ensure the uniform handling and display of			
8	flags at City facilities; and			
9	WHEREAS, the Flag Policy also set forth guidelines for the display of commemorate flags;			
10	and			
11	WHEREAS, under the Flag Policy, a commemorative flag means a flag that identifies with			
12	specific date, historical event, cause, or group of people, whereby the City honors or commemorates			
13	the date, event, cause, or people by flying the flag; and			
14	WHEREAS, commemorative flags may be displayed only as authorized by resolution of the			
15	City Council and as an expression of the City's official sentiments; and			
16	WHEREAS, per the Flag Policy, commemorative flags may be displayed at City Hall and,			
17	where possible, at other City facilities upon City Council action, consistent with the City's vision,			
18	mission, and strategic plan; and			
19	WHEREAS, on January 16, 2024, the City Council reviewed and approved the			
20	commemorative flags schedule for the upcoming year and directed staff to return to a subsequent City			
21	Council meeting with a resolution supporting the City's display of the flags chosen; and			
22	WHEREAS, on January 23, 2024, a Councilmember requested an agenda item be brought			
23	forward for a commemorative flag for Development Disabilities Awareness Month, in accordance			
24	with the process for consideration of new flags under the City's flag policy; and			
25	WHEREAS, on January 31, 2024, staff solicited input from the Human Relations Commission			
26	("Commission") on how to recognize groups and causes which do not have established			
27	commemorative flags; and

WHEREAS, the Commission also expressed support for adding Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month to the commemorative flag schedule however, there is no commemorative flag for this specific cause; and

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2024, the City Council adopted a resolution authorizing the commemorative flag schedule for the upcoming year, consisting of Holocaust Remembrance Day, Black History Month, Women's Suffrage Victory Flag, LGBTQ Pride Month and Juneteenth; and

WHEREAS, at the same meeting, the City Council approved display of the Disability Pride Month flag during the month of July and directed staff to return to Council with a resolution supporting the City's display of this flag; and

WHEREAS, Disability Pride Month is recognized in July, and celebrates people with disabilities, their identities, their culture, and contributions to society; and

WHEREAS, the Disability Pride Month flag aims to convey that there is nothing wrong with having a disability and encourages pride in one's identity; and

WHEREAS, the Disability Pride Month flag serves as a powerful emblem of acceptance, resilience, and celebration within the disability community, and a reminder to honor and appreciate the diverse contributions of people with disabilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals set forth above are incorporated herein as findings by the City Council.

<u>Section 2</u>. Per the Flag Policy adopted via Resolution No. 23947, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, commemorative flags may be displayed at City Hall and, where possible, at other City facilities, and shall be consistent with the City's vision, mission, and strategic plan.

Section 3. Per the Flag Policy, the City Council hereby authorizes the display of the Disability Pride Month commemorative flag at City Hall and, where possible, at other City facilities, during the month of July. All other previously approved commemorative flags for 2024 shall remain unchanged.
